PA/2013/0624: To undertake various works to trees protected by the Tree Preservation (Kingsferry Wharf, Burton Upon Stather) Order 2013 involving:
 1. Felling a Willow Tree (T2 on the application drawing);
 2. Reducing the crown of two Willow Trees (T1 and T3 on the Application drawing), by pollarding;
 3. Felling a Rowan Tree (T5 on the application drawing), and;
 4. Felling two Lime Trees (T6 and T7 on the application drawing – To be replaced with two cherry trees).

Site Location: Kingsferry Wharf, Stather Road, Burton Upon Stather
Applicant: Mr M Smith, Kingsferry Wharf (RSL) Ltd
