3. To discuss and agree the offer from Mr Giles Johnston on behalf of Normanby Estate Company Limited/Normanby Estate Holdings Limited (NE) for permissive paths within the Burton Upon Stather Parish.

i. Winterton Beck Lane path meeting with Carr Lane path. (Path No. 7 and 2)

NE offered to fill the flooded area on the Carr Lane path to make this accessible. If this was not feasible or the work could not be completed, consideration would be given for permissive access from Winterton Beck Lane path to the Crowston Track path.

RESOLVED: To support this proposal.

ii. Crowston Track Path (Map No. 2)

NE did not wish to offer this as a permissive path other than as stated in item 1.

RESOLVED: To support this proposal although would wish this path to be used if Carr Lane is not accessible for use.

iii. A new permissive path between Thealby and Normanby, inside the hedge to meet/pass FP164.

RESOLVED: To support this proposal. The Council requested the entrance/exit from the field close to Normanby leads onto the public footpath leading to the village or the hall.

iv. Cougar Path (Path No. 8)

NE did not wish walkers to use this footpath.

RESOLVED: To support this proposal.

- v. Winterton Beck Path leading to Bagmoor Farm (Map No. 7)

NE did not wish a permissive footpath between the Crowston Track and Bagmoor Farm.

RESOLVED: To support this proposal.

- vi. The Tranmere Wood path, from Burton Road and Bridleway 22 (Path No. 3)

NE would grant a permissive footpath if there was no alternative route.

RESOLVED: To support this as a permissive path. This is a well-used path that could be closed on shoot days.

- vii. Riverbank FP170-FP171 through the ponds and right by the brick pond to Chafer Lane (Map No. 5)

RESOLVED: To support this as a permissive path however to inform NE that, as the land has more than one landowner, the Parish Council would prefer this path to be added to the Definitive Map.

- viii. Track leading from Wood Bottom, around the fields on the Flixborough Warp and returning to Wood Bottom (Map No. 6)

RESOLVED: To support the proposal to this becoming a permissive path.

- ix. Extension of FP173 to the Riverbank (Map No. 4)

RESOLVED: This footpath leads from Burton Wood to Flixborough Grange. To request an extension to the riverbank.

- x. The Old Beacon Path, Burton Hills (Map No.1)

This footpath was not discussed in great detail on 30 May 2014. It crosses land under lease to Burton Upon Stather Parish Council.

RESOLVED: Burton Upon Stather Parish Council recommends this footpath is added to the Definitive Map.
