Proposals were received from North Lincolnshire Council to install a 7.5 weight restriction for the B1430 and the C107 commencing at The Pinfold, Thealby, and the nearest roundabout to Normanby Hall at the entrance to the Flixborough Industrial Estate, Scunthorpe.

RESOLVED: No objection. The following comments were submitted.

Two signs to be displayed on the A1077; one when approaching the B1430 from Hull and the other when approaching from Scunthorpe. The signs to be displayed on the A1077 when approaching the B1430 should read 'Access to Burton, Wharf and Thealby only'.

To request North Lincolnshire Council ensure appropriate signage is displayed on the B1430 when leaving Scunthorpe and the Flixborough Industrial Estate that traffic adhere to the 7.5 weight restriction and not enter the parish along this route unless visiting businesses within the weight restriction.
